Computing

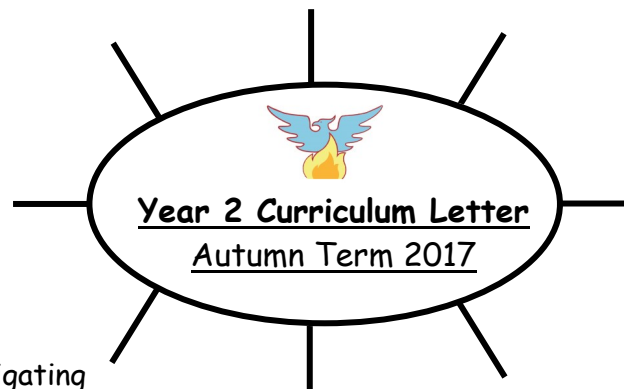
In Computing sessions, we shall be learning how to save and print our work. We shall be using a drawing program to create a picture.
