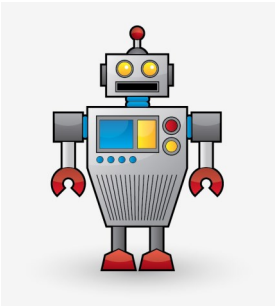

This term's theme is ROBOTS.

Music

We shall be exploring classical music from the Baroque era.



English

Our text types this term are:

- ◇ Reports
- ◇ Narrative stories
- ◇ Poetry

Art

Our focus is drawing. We will be learning a range of skills to improve drawing from observation and imagination.

Computing

Elements of digital literacy and information technology will be explored. We shall also work on programming robots.

MfL (French)

All children will learn a few French words and short simple phrases. This term we will concentrate on learning greetings, numbers and colours.

History

We shall be learning about chronology and locating different time periods on a time line.

Geography

We shall be investigating maps to follow routes around our school grounds, using maps and atlases to locate countries in Europe and the UK.

DT

We shall be making Robot models and designing question and answer boards using our knowledge of Electrical circuits. Later in the term, we will also design and make some tasty treats to sell at the Winter Market.

Science

Magnets, Forces and Electricity will be the focus for this term's Science learning. The children will plan and carry out a range of investigations.

PE

This term we shall be improving our racket and ball skills and taking part in weekly dance sessions led by a professional dancer.

RE

We will be learning about the teachings and authorities of different religions, to make comparisons.
