Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 1 Trip to Skegness

At the start of another exciting term, Year 1 are already planning another **trip**. We will be going to **Skegness beach, the lifeboat station and the aquarium on Tuesday 21st May**. This will support our Geography learning, as we are finding out about aspects of life in a coastal town and also links to our Science topics about plants and animals. We will be travelling by coach from school at approximately **9 am** to Skegness and will return by coach before the end of the school day so **it is important that children arrive to school on time**.

We are asking for a voluntary donation of **£10.00 per child** for the trip. This will be put towards the cost of the coaches and the entrance fee to Skegness Aquarium. Please send this into school **by Wednesday 15th May**.

Your child will need to wear **school uniform** and will require a **sun hat and named suncream (depending on the weather), a waterproof coat and a water bottle, all contained in a backpack**. As your child will be doing lots of walking and going on the beach, they **may wear trainers** on the trip but please could you also ensure that your child has **wellies in school on the day** in case they are needed due to wet weather. If your child suffers from **travel sickness**, please ensure they are given the appropriate medication. If a further tablet is required for the return journey, please place this in a **clearly marked envelope with your child's name and instructions for taking**. This should be handed to their class teacher on the morning of the trip.

Your child will require a packed lunch. If you have already booked a hot dinner with the Farm Kitchen for this day there are 2 options:-
