Dear Parents/Carers,

At Boston West we believe in bringing learning to life and giving children memorable learning experiences. The children have thoroughly enjoyed watching caterpillars turn into butterflies this term, therefore **next term we would like to link our learning to the chick life cycle**. During next term we will be having a special delivery of 20 eggs! The children will have the opportunity to look after the eggs in an incubator, watch the chicks hatch and care for them. They will even have the opportunity to hold a chick too.
