Year 4 Trip to Woodside Wildlife Park

Dear Parents/Carers,

At the start of another exciting term, Year 4 are planning an exciting trip to **Woodside Wildlife Park** on **Monday 20th May**. This will support our science learning, as we are finding out about habitats, adaptations and animal life cycles.

We will be travelling by coach from school at approximately **9 am** to Lincoln and will return by coach before the end of the school day so **it is important that children arrive to school on time**. We are asking for a voluntary donation of **£12.50 per child** for the trip. This will be put towards the cost of the coaches and the entrance fee to Woodside Wildlife Park. Please send this into school **by Thursday 16th May**.

Your child will need to wear **school uniform** and will require a **sun hat and named sun cream (depending on the weather)**, a **waterproof coat and a water bottle, all contained in a backpack**. As your child will be doing lots of walking around the park, they may wear trainers on the trip. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they are given the appropriate medication. If a further tablet is required for the return journey, please place this in a **clearly marked envelope with your child's name and instructions for taking**. **This should be handed to their class teacher on the morning of the trip**.

There will be an opportunity to visit the park's gift shop during the visit. Therefore, if your child would like to bring a **maximum of £3** to purchase a souvenir, they should bring the money in a **clearly labelled, sealed envelope and hand it to their group leader**, on the day.

Your child will require a packed lunch. If you have already booked a hot dinner with the Farm Kitchen for this day there are 2 options:-
